RE: Potential Water District No. 1

Dear Town of Lorraine Water District No. 1 residents:

Since some time has passed since the last public informational meeting, the Town Board felt it would be appropriate to provide a status update on the proposed Town of Lorraine Water District No. 1 project.

The Preliminary Engineering Report which outlines the proposed district area, budget, and user costs was finalized in July 2015. This report was used to prepare funding applications for the New York State Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and the New York State Department of State Local Government Efficiency Grant program via the Consolidated Funding Application process. The Town was not successful in securing funding through these avenues in 2015. In 2016, the Town again applied to the New York State Department of State Local Government Efficiency Grant via the Consolidated Funding Application process in 2016 and was unsuccessful. The Town has met with a representative from Senator Ritchie's office to review the project and determine if any assistance can be provided.

The Town would like to conduct another public informational meeting to review the next steps of the project and other important information. The proposed project area remains the same and includes Washington Park Road up to County Route 189, County Route 189 from Washington Park Road to the Village of Adams line, and Route 11 from the Village of Adams line to Meat Market Road.

The public informational meeting will be held on May 25, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Lorraine Municipal Building. Residents are encouraged to attend the meeting.
