

SEPTEMBER 27, 2017 UNOFFICIAL PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES UNTIL OCTOBER MEETING

The Lorraine Town Board opened their Public Hearing to hear comments on the proposed Local Law #2 of 2017, Notice of Highway Defects, Prior Written Notice and the proposed Local Law #3 of 2017 to Override the Tax Levy Limit at 7:00 pm at the Municipal Building.

Present were: Town Supervisor Vince Moore, Councilman David Johnson, Councilperson Virginia Clemens, and Town Clerk/Tax Collector Melinda Milne. Absent were: Councilman Joe Hodges and Councilman Lester Hobbs.

Citizens present were: Judge Eric Sheldon.

The Town Clerk read the Legal Notice that was published in the Watertown Daily Times.

Judge Sheldon was recognized and had no comments regarding the proposed local laws.

MOTION #72 OF 2017 was made by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Councilperson Clemens to close the public hearing at 7:03 pm. All present were in favor. Motion was carried.

Councilman Johnson discussed some issues with the fire alarm system. The Board reviewed quotes that Mr. Johnson obtained to update the system. The Board discussed. In addition, the Board discussed the boiler system update. There is no known start date for the project.
